### NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under Sub-Section(1) of Section 67 of Motor Vehicles Act 1988 (Central Act 59/88), the Government of Karnataka issued notification No.HTD 4 TMA 98, Dated 6-6-1998 directing the Karnataka State Transport Authority and Regional Transport Authorities to fix the minimum and maximum fare for transportation of passengers by City Taxies (Motor Cabs) operating within 25 kms. of the city limits in Karnataka State. Whereas, notification No.HTD 175 TMA 99, Dated 24-2-2001 was subsequently issued, duly revising the said fares. Fares were further revised by issuing Notification No.TRD 407 SAEPA 2005, Dated 9-11-2006.

With the rapid development of all the cities in Karnataka including the City of Bangalore in recent times, it is felt necessary by the Government to introduce upgraded Air-conditioned City Taxies (Motor Cabs) keeping in view the need to meet the demand of the representatives of Corporate sectors and foreign tourists as well.

Wherefore, in addition to the existing City Taxies already introduced vide Notification read above, it is decided by the Government to introduce a separate class of City Taxies (Motor Cabs) viz., "Air Conditioned City Taxies, with engine capacity of not less than 1200 CC" and directions are hereby issued to the State Transport Authority and the Regional Transport Authorities concerned to fix a separate fare for transportation of passengers and their luggages by this type of city taxies.

### DIRECTIONS

For Air conditioned City Taxies with engine capacity of not less than 1200 CC operating within 25 kms. from City limits of all the Cities of Karnataka State, the following rates are fixed.

The State Transport Authority and Regional Transport Authorities are hereby directed to fix the following fares for a separate class of Air conditioned city Taxies with engine capacity of not less than 1200 CC operating within 25 kms. from the city limits of all the Cities in Karnataka State, for transportation of passengers and their luggages, with immediate effect.

1. For the distance of 4 kms. minimum fare – Rs.60/- (Engine capacity of the Air conditioned City Taxi shall not be less than 1200 CC)
2. For every next one km distance – Rs.15/-
3. Waiting charges- For the first 20 minutes – no fare, for the next every 15 minutes or part thereof – Rs.10/-
4. Luggage (Suitcase, Bedding etc.) charges :- For the first 30 kgs. no charge. For every additional 20 kgs. or part thereof – Rs.5/-

NOTE : Night from 10 O'clock to morning 6 O'clock or for the journey outside the city limits, the fare and freight shall not exceed one and a half time of the above fare. Further, the guidelines and conditions laid down vide Notification No.FTD 4 TMA 98 dated 6-6-98 which are applicable to ordinary city taxies are also applicable to Air conditioned City Taxies.
